Well worth entering contest

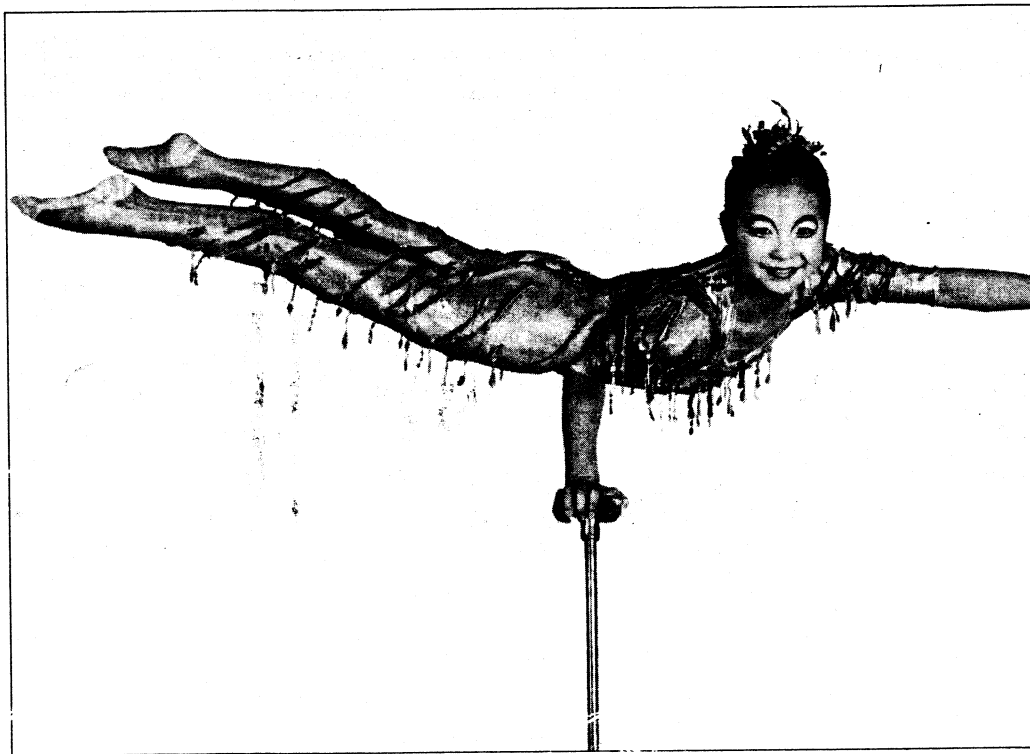
We certainly experienced the wow factor by winning a set of tickets to the world-class show *Cirque Du Soleil — Dralion*. The show was nothing short of spectacular.
